The Illinois Department of Revenue (IDOR) body worn camera information for CY2025 is reported below:

- 1) Agency Overview:  
IDOR's Bureau of Criminal Investigation and Internal Affairs Division employ sworn special agents throughout the state to conduct investigations of violations of the Illinois Tax Acts and related financial crimes.
- 2) Number of Body Worn Cameras:  
IDOR has a stock of 36 Motorola V700 Body Worn Cameras. There are currently 26 body cameras issued out to sworn agents.
- 3) Technical Issues:  
There were no known technical issues during this reporting period.
- 4) Supervisor Review Process:  
Supervisors review body worn camera footage when reviewing activity reports, in the event of a complaint, upon receipt of a FOIA request, and for training purposes. Additionally, all footage is reviewed and disseminated as requested or required by the Special Agent in Charge/or designee prior to sending.
