Overview of Agency

The Alsip Police Department has forty-four (44) sworn Officers who utilize forty-four (44) body worn cameras. The Department implemented the cameras as a part of a phase training program beginning in January 1st, 2024. The entire Department was utilizing body cameras by the mandated date of July 1st, 2025.

Technical Issues

The Department experienced minor issues with the Axon 3 Body Cameras. The issues encountered were the replacement of one body camera due to a cracked screen. The issue was quickly resolved and replaced by Axon.

Review Process

Supervisors are authorized to review relevant recordings anytime they are investigating alleged misconduct or reports of meritorious service that would require the review of said footage. Supervisors are required to review at least one body camera video from each Officer on their shift each month for a traffic stop and a call for service. The reviews are completed to ensure proper functioning of the body camera and proper recording per the Department policy. Infractions should be discussed with the Officer to improve performance.
