



Department Overview – Aurora University Police Department 2025

The Aurora University Police Department consists of twenty-two (22) sworn officers (15 full time and 7 part time). These officers utilize ten (10) Motorola V700 body worn cameras, owned by the department, and rotated by shift.

AUPD did not receive any grant funding for the purchase of the devices.

Technical Issues

Aurora University Police did not experience any technical issues with any of the cameras during this reporting period.

Review Process

The Aurora University Police Department Deputy Chief of Police conducts monthly audits of all sworn officers' body worn camera usage. Three random videos from each officer are selected, watched in entirety, and each viewing/review documented. In the event of a complaint, the Deputy Chief would immediately ensure the security of the recording.

The Chief of Police reviews the Deputy Chief's body worn camera data in the same manner, with monthly audit reporting.

Incidents

Between January 1, 2025 and December 31, 2025, the Aurora University Police Department documented one (1) incident for criminal trespass and one (1) warrant arrest. Neither incident required transmission of body worn camera data to the State's Attorney.
