The Casey Police Department implemented its body-worn camera program in July 2024, utilizing Motorola V700 cameras. As of December 31, 2025 the department had 8 sworn positions, all sworn officers were assigned to their own Body-Worn Cameras.

The Casey Police Department originally used an Onsite Server for video storage. In July 2024 the video footage was transitioned to VideoManager EL Cloud.

Our program consists of 8 Body-Worn Cammers and six patrol squads containing 4RE in-car video cameras.

Quality Control Guidelines include:

Viewing of the Body Worn Cameras footage by the officers, periodically to ensure the video and audio quality meet expectations.

Video footage viewed by the Chief of Police periodically to ensure appropriate dialog and techniques are being utilized by all officers. If any issues are discovered the Chief uses the best course of action to remedy the situation.

Videos are also reviewed during the FOIA and redaction processing.

Technical issues:

Minor Wear and Tear issues have occurred.

The in-car cameras were not downloading until parked next to the Police station, causing a delay in reviewing footage.

Motorola V700 and 4RE are operational and effective for our needs at the Police Station.
