The Marshall Police Department is comprised of ten officers, each utilizing body worn cameras. Officers include the Chief of Police, Assistant Chief of Police, Investigator, and seven patrol officers. The department utilizes one patrol officer as a school resource officer who covers four schools within the city limits.

Currently, there have not been any technical issues with the operation of the body worn cameras. The only issues were prior to deployment, which involved the transfer of video to cloud storage. These issues were resolved by Motorola and our local IT department through reconfiguring the switch and internal software changes made by Motorola.

Body worn camera reviews are done periodically by the Chief of Police and/or the Investigator. Each officer is evaluated through body worn camera review at least twice a year, unless additional reviews are warranted. If issues are found with the officer's interaction with the public, duties being performed, or any other issues, they are addressed by the Chief of Police accordingly.
