### **2025 Annual Body Worn Camera Report**

#### ***Department Overview – Tilton Police Department***

The Tilton Police Department has an authorized sworn member capacity at twelve (12). Currently the department consists of twelve (12) sworn members and maintains body-worn cameras. Full-time (8) and part-time members (4) utilize twelve (12) cameras if they are actively engaged in law enforcement activities. Our department maintains four (4) spares.

#### ***Technical Issues / Upgrade***

There were no reported technical issues with our body worn cameras or system during 2025.

#### ***Review Process***

Tilton Police Department supervisors may review body worn camera videos in the following instances:

*Audits* – On a random basis, a supervisor will review videos from each officer under their command to ensure proper activation and tagging.

*Use of Force Reviews* – If an officer uses force, the applicable video is reviewed.

*Citizen Complaints* – If a complaint is made against a member of the department the associated video is reviewed.

*Field Training* – Trainee videos are reviewed to gauge the development of the recruit during the field training program.

*Other* – Videos may be reviewed if supervisors are made aware of exceptional performance, live saving measures or other actions resulting in receiving recognition.
