ILETSB Body Worn Camera Report 2025

Equipment: The Manhattan Police Department uses the Getac camera platform for our body worn cameras and our in-car dash cameras. We currently have 16 full- time and 3 part-time sworn members who use the cameras. We have 16 body cameras in our system.

Technology: We experience poor battery life on our body cameras. This requires the officers to dock the cameras in the patrol car to charge at some point during a 12 or 16 hour shift. Alternatively, they may elect to swap out the camera for a freshly charged camera. Otherwise, we generally do not experience any issues with the software or operating system.

Review: Our supervisors are required to review a minimum sampling of 3 body camera recordings per officer per month to check for policy compliance and professionalism. Reviews will also be completed on significant incidents. The patrol commander will also review camera footage on a regular basis.
