Re: 2025 Body Worn Camera Report

Pursuant to the Illinois Body Worn Camera Act, the Moraine Valley Community College Police Department provides this information regarding our Body Worn Camera program.

The Moraine Valley Community College Police Department consists of (21) sworn Illinois law enforcement officers. A Body Worn Camera is assigned to each officer. In our inventory we have (21) active Body Worn Camera devices.

On a monthly basis, supervisors' access and review officer recorded Body Worn Camera footage for performance assessments and policy compliance. In addition, supervisors review if officers are properly documenting Body Worn Camera use in incident reports.

There are no Body Worn Camera technical issues to report.

Body-worn camera footage was provided to the State's Attorney's Office for two incidents that resulted in arrest charges: one involving theft and one involving battery.
