In accordance with the Illinois Law Enforcement Officer-Worn Body Camera Act and associated grant requirements, please find below the 2025 annual report for the Southern Illinois University Edwardsville Police Department's (SIUE PD) body-worn camera (BWC) and in-car camera (ICC) program.

Department Overview: The SIUE Police Department currently consists of 40 sworn police officers, each of whom is assigned their own body-worn camera. All officers are required to utilize their body-worn cameras and in-car cameras accordance with department policy and state law.

Program Oversight and Compliance: Supervisors (Sergeants) conduct monthly reviews of calls for service and case-related video recordings for each officer under their supervision. These reviews are formally documented on a recurring basis to ensure accountability and policy compliance.
