TINLEY PARK POLICE DEPARTMENT BODY WORN CAMERA REPORT (2026)

The Tinley Park Police Department consists of sixty-eight (68) officers who utilize sixty-eight (68) body-worn cameras.

Technical Issues

The Tinley Park Police Department reports user errors, as well as wear and tear issues. The Tinley Park Police Department updated their cameras to the new Getac BC-04 in late March through mid-April 2026.

Review Process

The Tinley Park Police Department supervisors and administrators have a right to review body worn camera videos when participating in official investigation, such as a personnel complaint, administrative investigations, or criminal investigations. Furthermore, supervisors have the right to view one (1) randomly selected body worn camera recordings to ensure compliance with policy and procedure as well as assess the need for training and tactics.

Incidents

Between 01 January 2026 and 30 April 2026, the Tinley Park Police Department reported three hundred twenty-six (326) incidents where charges were filed. Here is a top ten of the greatest frequency of those offenses charged.
